**How do you think your lesson went?**

This lesson was one of the best lessons that we've accomplished over the past two years. Students had expressed an interest in Crime Scene Investigation techniques after completing a Virtual Field Trip with Distance Learning involving a Crime Lab and Scientist. They have watched many of the CSI shows on television and played a computer simulation game with their teacher.

**What worked really well?**

Students completed the activity with enthusiasm and positive feedback. They have asked to continue the Crime Scene Investigation experience with further labs on DNA and fingerprinting.

**In this lesson is there anything you would decide to do differently the next time?**

The first time we did the lesson, we found that organizing the workstations and using a timer for the activity helped to improve the lesson.

**Will you use this lesson again?**

Yes, I have already done this lesson with other grade levels and other schools. We are developing more activities for the DNA and fingerprinting labs.

**Did the students seem to find the lesson worthwhile?**

Students enjoyed the extended activities about hair anatomy and growth and fiber analysis. Our goals in challenging the students to engage in inquiry activities and scientific observation were exceeded.
