Creating your PowerPoint Presentation:

1. Create a storyboard for your presentation

2. Create 4 slides

Title slide: Include a title for your problem, your name, class, and date

Type your word problem

Explain your strategy

Solve your problem using your strategy

3. Use graphics to illustrate your work

Clipart

Photos

Scanned images



4. Use the following design principles

Consistency (only 2 fonts repeated on all slides; same transition for all slides)

No sound effects

1 background effect

5. Create a puzzle book

Print your work.

1) Click **Print**

2) Choose **Handouts**

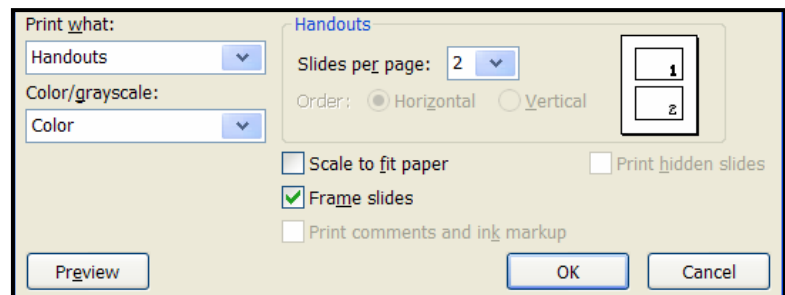
3) Choose **2 Slides**

Glue slide to index cards

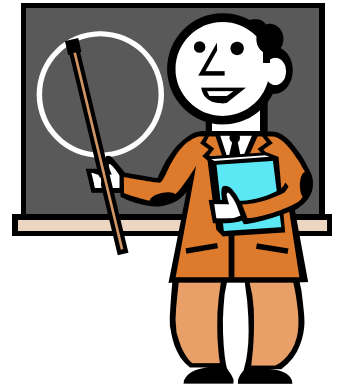
Clip them together and turn in for laminating and book binding

6. Present to classmates

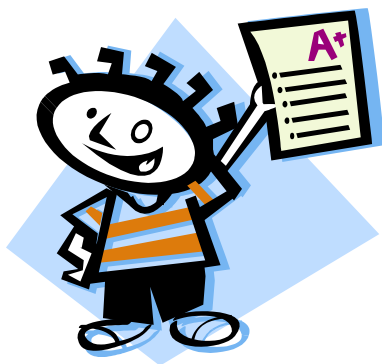
- Be prepared/practice your presentation
