Janel's Professional Goals:

1. Assist teacher develop confidence in troubleshooting technology issues that occur during student lessons

Asked to Look For:

- Questioning techniques that utilize open ended questions
- Manner of presentation in which teacher/mentee feels comfortable
- Maintain eye contact with teacher/mentee during interview

Observations

- Your questions allowed the teacher to explain her goals and methods of carrying out the lesson. The questions also allowed the teacher to elaborate and walk herself through the lesson, strategize and create solutions for potential problems.
